


Graphical Representation of Teacher's Feedback on Curriculum 2021-2022









Quality and relevance of the courses included in the curriculum 12 responses




Academic ambience of College for an effective delivery of courses 12 responses




Courses in terms of inclusion of latest knowledge/technology






Scope for the use of ICT for the delivery of courses


















Research orientation obtained during the programme 7 responses
